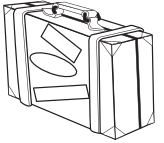

Why would anyone find it desirable to leave the place they were born and their extended family?



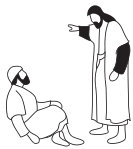
Since the passage or NAFTA, Mexicans can buy U.S. wheat cheaper than wheat grown in Mexico by Mexican farmers.
