Homeless Offering - February 28th
The Housing and Homeless Council distributes all Homeless Offering gifts as grants to churches and ministries that provide services and housing to poor and homeless persons through our Conference.

Wesley Woods - Mother's Day, May 8th

Wesley Woods serves the health and housing needs of older adults at 9 communities throughout North Georgia. The Mother's Day Offering helps cover the cost of health care, meals and wellness programs for low income residents.





Annual Conference Special Offering - May 29th

Each year churches across the Conference collect a special offering that is shared at Annual Conference in June.

Murphy-Harpst - July 17th

Murphy Harpst transforms the lives of Georgia's abused and neglected children through loving, Christian care and personalized treatment programs.





Golden Cross - August 21st

Golden Cross is a fund administered by the Conference Health and Welfare Committee to provide assistance to persons who are experiencing financial difficulty due to excessive medical expenses.

UM Children's Home Offering - September 18th
The United Methodist Children's Home provides redemptive, healing services that bring meaningful change to the lives of children and families.





Aldersgate/Collinswood- October 23rd

Aldersgate serves persons with developmental disabilities by assisting adults in securing safe, affordable, comfortable residential placements. Aldersgate also operates Collinswood, a universally accessible retreat facility.
