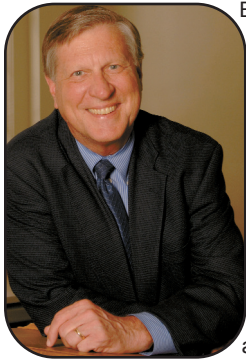


Epworth By The Sea

Bandy Professor of Preaching at Candler School of Theology is a Presbyterian minister. He has served churches in Georgia and New Jersey, taught preaching at Erskine, Columbia and Princeton Theological Seminaries. Author of textbooks on preaching and worship, collections of sermons, and biblical commentaries on Matthew and Hebrews, his most recent books are Preaching from Memory to Hope, Testimony: Talking Ourselves into Being Christian, and The Witness of Preaching. Second Edition.

Atmosphere in Worship:

Dr. Don Saliers



is Professor of Theology and Worship, Emeritus, at Candler. Educated at Ohio Wesleyan, Yale Divinity School and Cambridge Universities, he received his doctoral degree from Yale University. He taught at Yale Divinity School before joining the faculty at Emory, retiring after teaching 42 years.

Dr. Saliers is organist/choirmaster at Emory's Cannon Chapel. He contributed to the United Methodist Hymnal, The Book of Worship, and to the recent Upper Room Worshipbook. He lectures, preaches, leads retreats and has taught at Notre Dame, St. John's, Vancouver School of Theology and Boston College.

His publications include Filled With Light, Worship As Theology: Foretaste of Glory Divine, Worship and Spirituality, Worship Come To Its Senses, and Music and Theology. He and his daughter Emily wrote A Song to Sing, A Life to Live. Emily is one-half of the Grammy-Award winning Indigo Girls. He is editor of the hymn collection, Sounding Glory.

Theology of Worship:

Dr. Lisa Allen's undergraduate degree from Millsaps College is in Piano Performance and Music Education. Her Master's and Ph.D. degrees in Music Education are from the University of Southern Mississippi. After teaching music in Atlanta, she served as Minister of Music for Cascade, Ben Hill, Andrews Chapel, and Central. She graduated from Candler and was ordained an Elder in the NGA Conference. In 2005, she was appointed to the ITC as Assist. Professor of Church Music. She serves as Pastor of Worship at the East Point 1st Mallalieu UM Church.



Music and Arts in Worship:

Professor Ginger Wyrick, conductor, author, clinician, lecturer, teacher, and performer is an Assist. Professor of Music at Queens University. She leads workshops and lectures on music education and church music; serves as an adjudicator for piano, voice, and choral festivals. She has published Singing Between the Lines, FaithSongs, Church Music for Children, the production book and teaching plans for Joseph: What a Life!, The Choir Member's Companion, Church Choir 101, and The Choir Director's Organizer. She received the Bachelor of Music degree from UNC, Master of Music and Master of Sacred Music in conducting from Southern Methodist University.



Technology in Worship:

Rev. David Wood is a graduate of Georgia Tech. He earned his MD from Candler School of Theology. A Probationary Elder in the SGAC, he currently serves Macon Urban Ministries (the parent ministry of GNTV). As Senior Event Director, he produces events, plans worship services, and focuses on technological resources. He is helping to start a new ministry, Stable Affordable Family Enrichment, which seeks to provide affordable housing in communities that lack modern and affordable homes.
