WELCOME TO THE NEXT FAITHFUL STEP INITIATIVE

The Next Faithful Step Initiative is a congregational, team-based journey designed to further equip congregations for a more fruitful congregational and community life. Next Steps, a partnership of North Georgia's Connectional Ministries, Congregational Development, and Episcopal Offices, seeks to strengthen congregations and principled leaders in our annual conference for long-term growth and missional engagement. Through three phases, Next Steps engages clergy and lay teams as partners in effective ministry. Trained coaches come alongside congregational leaders to help congregations effectively fulfill their mission of making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.

Phase One: Shared Learning

What is it? In Phase I, each church establishes a balanced, diverse, and multi-generational lay team of at least six (and as many as 10% of worship attendance) that meets with teams from cohort congregations for seven Saturday learning sessions. Appointed clergy attend a Thursday session just for pastors. It is imperative that the lead pastor and, at least, six laity attend all sessions. Associate pastors are encouraged to attend with the lead pastor. The laity team may include paid staff, but must include key leaders as well. These learning sessions are designed to help each team learn key concepts and best practices to develop as congregational leaders. As a result, your congregation will set in motion a team of leaders to help it take its next faithful step.

When forming your Next Steps Team, please form a balanced, diverse, and multi-generational team of at least 6 lay people (or as many of 10% of your worship attendance) and all clergy.

- Balanced Short and long tenured members; people who have held leadership positions and influence and people who are marginalized or rarely heard in the planning and leadership life of your community.
- Diverse What does diversity look like for your church and community? Do your best to include all facets of diversity in your congregational life.
- Multi-Generational Please include people of all ages on your team. Include youth, young adults, adults, and older adults. Please also include people in different life stages (single, married, with and without children, widowed, etc.)

What to Expect:

Each session will consist of teaching, spiritual reflection, interaction with the ideas and concepts, and group sharing. Participants are required to read a book each month in order to contribute to each session's topic. Each church (clergy & lay) team is required to meet at least once between

sessions to debrief the session, discuss the readings, and to see how each person is progressing toward applying the learned concepts.

- Cost: Each church (or congregational leader) is asked to purchase their books for Phase I.

Site Visits for each participating congregation will be scheduled during the month of February. Next Steps staff will visit your church for an opportunity to get to know you and answer any questions about the Next Steps process.

What's Next?

Phase II includes 360° Evaluations, Hospitality Reports, On-Site Evaluations and Discovery of the Next Faithful Steps. This is conducted over a weekend in your local congregation. The cost for Phase II: \$1 per average worship attendee for Hospitality Reports.

Phase III includes Congregational Discernment and working with a trained coach to implement the discerned action plan. The cost for congregations in Phase III is based on each congregation's Next Faithful Step Action Plan. Minimally, the church will be responsible for the expenses accrued by your coach.

SCHEDULE: PHASE I

- Laity Sessions will be held on Saturdays at a central church location. Gather at 8:30 am for fellowship, light breakfast snacks, and coffee. Learning sessions will run from 9:00 am to Noon.
- Clergy Sessions will be held on Thursdays from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm and will rotate among the cohort churches.
