Prayers for Growing a Life of Joy

In his book, *Fruit-full Living: A Guide for Growing in God's Spirit,* Dr. Allen R. Hunt, senior pastor at Mount Pisgah Church in Alpharetta, Georgia, shares the following tips for growing a life of joy.

- **1. Find a joy mentor.** Regularly spend time with him or her. Imitate their routines. Identify their sources of joy.
- **2. Surround yourself with joyful people.** Seek environments that cultivate your joy. Avoid negative settings and people that carp and criticize.
- **3. Remind yourself daily where your hope lies.** "Whenever you face trials of any kind, consider it nothing but joy" (James 1:2). Trust God to never forsake you.
- 4. Let the joy of knowing and serving Jesus transform how you live. Find your ministry and pursue it joyfully.
- **5. Endow your children with joy.** Pass on the joy of Christ. Do things together that bring joy such as going to a movie or singing praises to God.
- 6. Make a thanksgiving list. Each day for a week list the specific things for which you are thankful. Then, give thanks to God in prayer.
- 7. Celebrate the Lord's Supper regularly. Remembering Jesus' sacrifice and feeling the Holy Spirit's presence during communion will lead to a deeper sense of joy.
