

## Prayers for Growing a Life of Love

In his book, *Fruit-full Living: A Guide for Growing in God's Spirit*, Dr. Allen R. Hunt, senior pastor at Mount Pisgah Church in Alpharetta, Georgia, shares 10 tips for growing a life of love.

1. Make a list of your enemies and pray for them daily.
2. Weekly serve another person who cannot benefit you in return.
3. Attend worship more than one time per week and seek to love God with your heart more fully.
4. Participate on a mission team to serve persons in crisis.
5. Take the first step and seek healing in a broken relationship. Begin with prayer, then show God's healing love with a letter of apology or a gift made in their honor.
6. Keep a daily prayer journal to grow your capacity to love. Pray regularly for friends and enemies. Each day list three blessings that you have received from God and give thanks.
7. Spend an entire day of uninterrupted time with your family.
8. Give sacrificially to a scholarship fund or children's home that is over and beyond your ordinary giving to God's ministries.
9. Send prayer cards to 10 persons in prison. Pray for other ways to show one or more prisoners the love of God.
10. Spend a morning visiting persons in a hospital who have no visitors. Love others as God has first loved you.
