- Volunteer as a family at a shelter, food pantry, or other place within the community that shows God's love to needy individuals.
- 5. Share at least one family meal per week. If family is not in the same location, choose a common day for a meal each week. As you dine separately, pray for one another or together by phone.
- 6. Seek out and share stories about love taking place in churches, schools, workplaces, and homes.
