Leader:

CONGREGATIONAL RESPONSE

People:

We do, with God's guidance and grace. As a part of this church, we pledge our loyalty and support. We shall strive to create among us a caring community. We will pray for you, and we trust that you will pray for us so that God may bless and prosper The Church.
